

## Great News! You can play Tennis again!

Revised advice from the NSW Office of Sport and under strict compliance with Government Public Health Orders and the [Tennis NSW COVID-19 Community Play Guidelines](#),

**Casual court hire can now proceed from Saturday April 4<sup>th</sup>.**

We see this as an opportunity for our Tennis Community to get outside and enjoy some valuable exercise but also understand people are only allowed to leave their homes for the purpose of exercise for 1hr per day.

The Executive met and decided our families deserve this opportunity in line with other Tennis Clubs and Centres across NSW **BUT** if the guidelines are **NOT** adhered to then we will have **NO** choice but to close the centre again so if you want to continue to enjoy your daily exercise on the tennis court for as long as the NSW Govt and Office of Sport allows then **PLEASE** don't 'drop the ball' on this one.

### **RULES AS FOLLOWS-**

- **It is your personal and social responsibility to bring alcohol/antiseptic wipes and wipe the pin pad on the gate before and after play**
- **A maximum of 2 people per Court (adhering to social distancing ie-1.5m apart)** \*Please Note Families who reside together - maximum of 4 people per Court.
- **Use your own marked balls so there is no need to share**
- **Don't swap ends during play**
- **Keep your water bottles at your end of the court**
- **No contact or touching the net/net posts/fences**
- **Court Hire is limited strictly to 1 hour**

Only Courts 8/10/12 will be available for Court Hire. The nets on Courts 7,9,11 have been removed to comply with social distancing rules as will the umpires chairs and scoreboards.

**Please ensure you leave when your scheduled court time is finished to allow time to pack up, wipe the pin pad and vacate the area before the arrival of the next booking.**

We have a great neighbourhood watch around the precinct as well as 'spot monitoring' will be in place and if any of the above is not followed, **all court hire will be suspended.**
